Global Integration Conference in Oman The Future Looks Bright

Further to the recent merger with Radici Film, a Global Integration Conference was held from 10th to 13th October at the Al Nahda Resort, Barka, in Oman welcoming over 50 delegates from all Ti sites.

During the conferences, speakers from different Ti sites and different business areas presented their joint work progress and results achieved in just 5 months after the merger: the standardization of our internal and external documentation across the sites, the harmonization of our product range, the creation of a new product data sheet and synoptic table, a new Ti website and Ti News underway, a new Sales organisation and many more innovations still to come in 2009. The Global Integration Conference closed very positively showing the great accomplishment of the first part of the integration phase. Above all, it was the opportunity for people from various sites, countries, languages, cultures and backgrounds, to get together, collaborate and demonstrate that diversity can successfully contribute to the growth of the Ti Group. Turnkey Project on Track with Tiptop Technology

Brückner Maschinenbau GmbH & Co has successfully supplied a high performance 8.7m wide BOPP film production line for the Taghleef Industries' plant



in Sohar, Oman. For this challenging project, Brückner was chosen not only as supplier for the film production but also to deliver a complete turnkey package for the new BOPP production plant, including the following services and peripheral equipment:

- integration of new BOPP production in existing site infrastructure,
- layout planning and engineering,
- planning, delivery and installation of all energy and utility supply systems (e.g. oil, compressed air, water treatment, cold and chilled water),
- piping and cabling,
- storage facilities for raw materials, slitters,

- mill roll and slit roll handling,
- packaging and storage incl. final warehouse, recycling plant.

Shortly after the start-up of the seventh joint project between *Ti* and Brückner, continuous production was attained and *Ti* is already marketing first grade film.

The annual capacity increase of 35,000 tons adds to a combined annual film production capacity approximating 260,000 tons, marking a new era for Taghleef Industries (*Ti*).

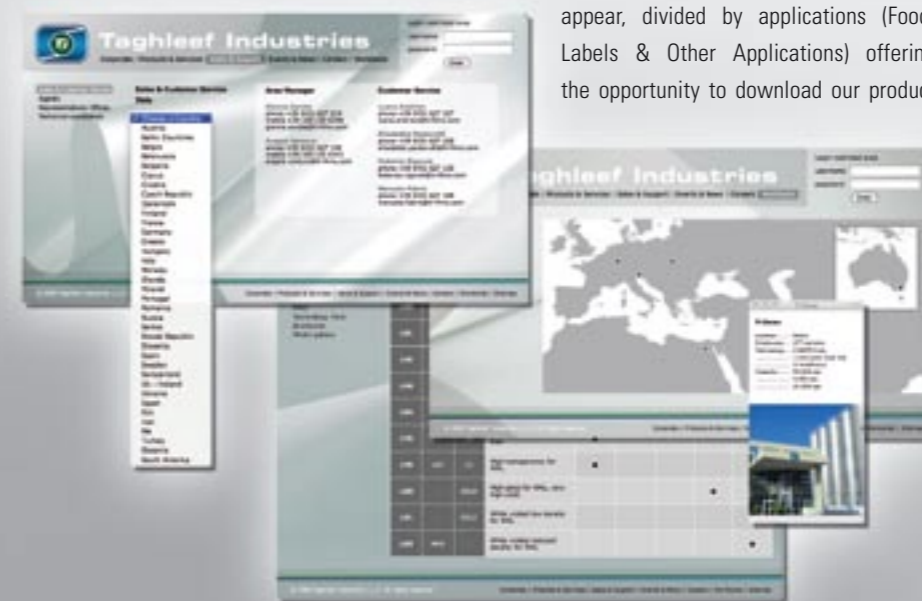

New Product Nomenclature

An important task in the process of integration between *Ti* Group and Radici Film was the harmonization of the product nomenclature.

All the new codes are composed of 3 letters, related to the main characteristics of each product. In particular, three categories are identified according to the final application of the film:

- Food packaging
- Labels
- Others

In general, for food applications, the choice of the letter is related to the aesthetic aspect (clear, matt, white, voided or metallised) and to the main characteristics of the film, e.g. sealability, COF, density and barrier.

All the films for labels begin with an "L", followed by a letter generally related to technology of application (WAL reel-fed,

WAL cut & stack, in mould, self adhesive). Special codes are dedicated to other films (tapes, single-folded, shrinkable).

On all *Ti* documents, next to the NEW

nomenclature, the "old" *Ti* and Radici names will be indicated for an appropriate period of time in order to allow our customers to gradually assimilate the new names.



A New look for our Product Data Sheets

Our new data sheets are now available! Completely redesigned, the data sheets will show alongside each other the new *Ti* product name and the old Radici Film product name in order to facilitate our customers' understanding of the new *Ti* product nomenclature.

The new product data sheets have been designed to easily locate the technical information whether it is about the roll size availability, the properties of the film or the general indication about the film treatment and storage.
